- The fund is passively managed.

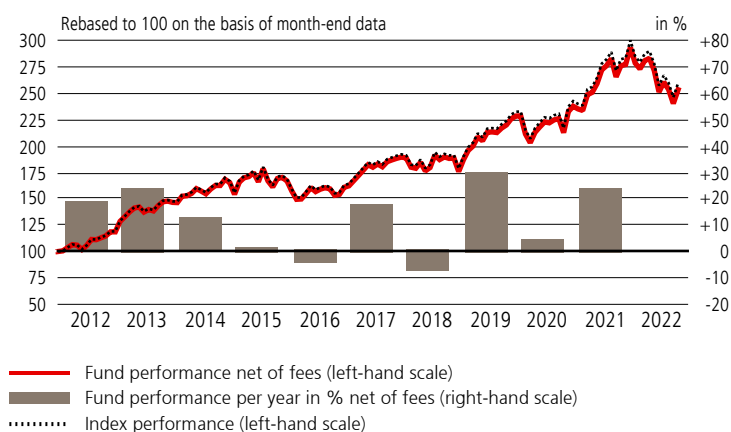
